



# PET COMMISSARY APPLICATION

The overall goal of El Paso Animal Services' Pet Resource Program is to keep families together and prevent the surrender of pets due to economic difficulties. The Pet Commissary lends a hand to those struggling to provide the basics for their animal family members, whether temporarily or on an ongoing basis. All of the food and supplies made available in this program are donated and so there is variation in the types, brands and quantity of items available at any given time.

In order to participate, clients are required to provide Animal Services with some basic information about themselves and their pets, including proof that the pets are spayed/neutered. For those applicants whose pets are not yet spayed/neutered, we offer resource information.

Once approved, clients will receive an El Paso Animal Services Pet Commissary I.D. card. This card and a photo I.D. will be needed in order to receive pet food and supplies. Please note that ONE CARD will be issued for each household, along with one allotment of food/supplies for each household.

***Please complete both sides of the application and return it to us in the attached stamped envelope, along with a copy of proof of spay/neuter for each pet.***
